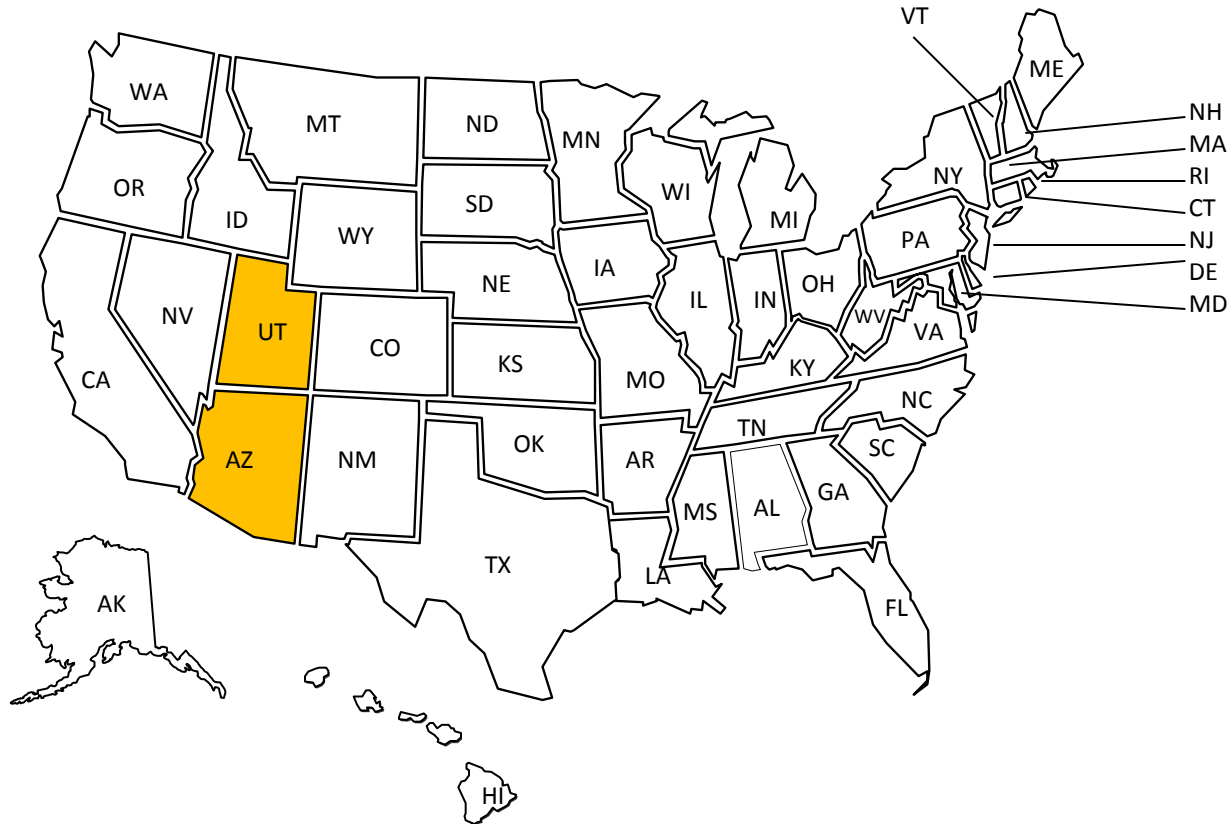


States that Require Practitioners to Register for PMP Database¹
