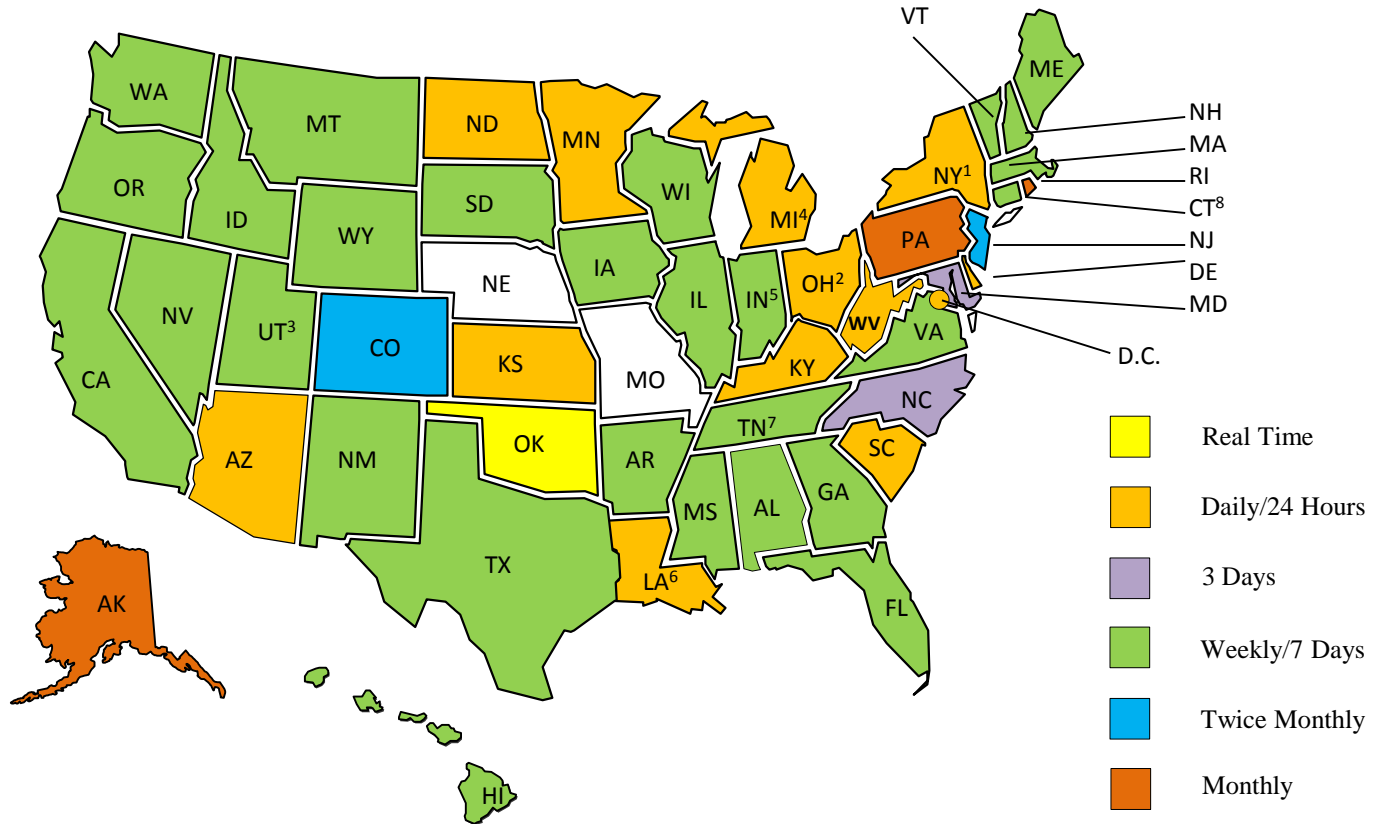




DATA COLLECTION INTERVAL

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Data Collection Interval



¹ New York requires the submission of data in real time by statute, but that has been interpreted by regulation to mean no later than 24 hours after the substance is delivered. ² Ohio requires submission of data from pharmacies daily and from wholesalers monthly. ³ Utah requires submission weekly, but for those participating in the statewide pilot program, submission is required daily. ⁴ Michigan requires daily reporting for online reporting of dispensing information and weekly for mail-in submission of data. ⁵ Indiana will begin requiring the submission of data within 3 days by July 1, 2015 and within 24 hours by January 1, 2016. ⁶ Louisiana begins daily reporting on August 1, 2014. ⁷ Tennessee will begin requiring daily submission on January 1, 2016. ⁸ Connecticut requires marijuana dispensaries to report marijuana dispensing to the PMP daily.
