<sup>1</sup> In addition to those substances scheduled by statute or regulation in Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Ohio, and Oregon, those states also incorporate the federal schedules by reference. Substances included in the federal schedules are, therefore, included as being banned by those states as well.

Note that due to different spellings and the different ways in which the molecular structures of these substances are written in state laws and regulations, this chart may not capture all of the substances banned in each state.
