H.B. 158 – read 1st time; in Senate committee 2/28/2012

S.B. 208 – passed Senate; in House committee 2/23/2012

- adds methylone, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone, 3-FMC, 4-FMC

Alaska:

S.B. 140 – passed Senate; referred to House 3/6/2012

H.B. 253 – referred to committee 2/10/2012

- adds MDPV, mephedrone, generic language

Arizona:

S.B. 1043 – passed Senate; referred to House 1/19/2012

H.B. 2356 – signed by Governor; effective on passage 2/17/2012

- adds fluoromethcathinone, butylone, MDPV, methylmethcathinone, methoxymethcathinone, NRG-1, methylone

Colorado:

S.B. 116 – third reading passed 3/9/2012

- adds metamfepramone, ethcathinone, a-PPP, buphedrone, a-PBP, a-PVP, mephedrone, MaPPP, MPBP, methedrone, MOPPP, fluoromethcathinone, methylone, MDPPP, MDPV, NRG-1

L.B. 645 – hearing set for 3/16 1/13/2012
