SUMMARY OF SUBSTITUTED CATHINONES BILLS AND PROPOSED REGULATIONS

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BILLS –

Arizona:

H.B. 2327 – signed by Governor; effective on passage 4/3/2013

- adds a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, butylone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDAI, MDPPP, MDPV, mephedrone, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, pentylone, and new generic language

Connecticut:

S.B. 121 – referred to committee 1/11/2013

- bans the sale of substances labeled as bath salts that have a similar effect as mephedrone and MDPV

D.C.:

L.B. 184 – adopted 4/1/2013

- adds BZP, ephedrone, MDPV, mephedrone, methylone

L.B. 645 (B19-645) – enacted 2/13/2013

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, a-PPP, a-PVP, butylone, BZP, ephedrone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDAI, MDPPP, MDPV, mephedrone, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1

L.B. 1109 (B19-1109) – signed by Mayor; effective on signing 1/14/2013

- adds BZP, ephedrone, mephedrone, methylone, MDPV

Florida:

H.B. 619 – substituted by S.B. 294; laid on table 4/17/2013

- adds 4-MeMABP, pentedrone

S.B. 294 – approved by Governor; effective on passage 4/24/2013

- adds 4-MeMABP, pentedrone

Louisiana:

H.B. 10 – signed by Governor; effective 8/1/2013 5/23/2013

- adds MDAI

Maine:

H.P. 1033 – signed by Governor; effective 90 days after end of session 6/24/2013

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, 4-MEC, butylone, eutylone, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone, methylone, NRG-1, pentedrone, pentylone, and generic language

Massachusetts:

H.B. 4383 – no further action taken 1/1/2013

- adds generic language, mephedrone, MDPV, methylone, methedrone, 4-FMC, 3-FMC, HMMC, MPBP, ephedrone, 4-EMC, 3,4-DMMC, a-PVP, NRG-1, butylone, pentylone, eutylone, MDAI, ethcathinone, metamfepramone, a-PPP, MOPPP, MDPPP, buphedrone, MDPBP

Montana:

H.B. 140 – signed by Governor; effective 10/1/2013 4/2/2013

- adds generic language

New York:

A.B. 717 – amend and recommit to committee 5/17/2013

- adds generic language
- requires commissioner to maintain a database of known substituted cathinones
- creates a statewide substituted cathinones surrender program

A.B. 6607 – referred to committee 4/12/2013

- adds 2-diphenylmethylpyrrolidine, MDAI

A.B. 6971 – referred to committee 4/29/2013

- adds definition of “synthetic cathinone” and generic language

A.B. 7893 – referred to committee 6/7/2013

- adds generic language

S.B. 1686 – referred to committee 6/11/2013

- adds generic language

S.B. 2441 – referred to committee 1/17/2013

- adds D2PM, MDAI

S.B. 3469 – passed Assembly; returned to Senate 6/19/2013

- adds generic language
- requires commissioner to maintain a database of known substituted cathinones

S.B. 5401 – referred to committee 5/16/2013

- adds definition of substituted cathinone with generic language and adds penalty provisions

North Dakota:

H.B. 1070 – signed by Governor; effective on signing 3/27/2013

- adds generic language with the following as examples: 2-FMC, 3,4-DMMC, 3-FMC, 4-FMC, 4-MEC, a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, buphedrone, butylone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDPPP, MDPV, mephedrone, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, pentedrone

Ohio:

H.B. 334 – signed by Governor; effective on signing 12/20/2012

- adds 2-DPMP, D2PM, MDAI
- adds generic language with the following as examples: 3-FMC, 4-FMC, a-PVP, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone, methylone, pentedrone, pentylone

S.B. 301 – signed by Governor; effective 3/13/2013 12/11/2012

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, methylone, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone

Oklahoma:

H.B. 2217 – approved by Governor 4/29/2013

- adds a-PVP, pentedrone

Pennsylvania:

H.B. 1217 – signed by Governor; effective on passage 7/2/2013

- adds generic language

Rhode Island:

H.B. 5325 – signed by Governor; effective on passage 7/15/2013

- adds BZP
- adds generic language with the following as examples: a-PPP, buphedrone, ethcathinone

S.B. 454 – signed by Governor; effective on passage 7/15/2013

- adds BZP and generic language with the following as examples: a-PPP, buephedrone, ethcathinone

South Carolina:

H.B. 3823 – requests for debate 5/22/2013

- adds 4-FMC, 4-MEC, buphedrone, butylone, BZP, MBZP, MDAI, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone, methylone, pentedrone, pentylone, generic language

S.B. 406 – passed Senate; in House committee 4/11/2013

- adds 4-FMC, 4-MEC, buphedrone, butylone, BZP, MBZP, MDAI, MDPV, mephedrone, methedrone, methylone, pentedrone, pentylone, generic language

South Dakota:

S.B. 68 – signed by Governor 3/6/2013

- adds 4-MBC, buphedrone, DMBDB, DMEC, DMMC, ethylethcathinone, ethylmethcathinone, eutylone, fluoroethcathinone, isopentedrone, MaPPP, MBP, MDDMA, MDMC, MDPBP, MEC, MOMC, MPBP, pentedrone, pentylone

Tennessee:

H.B. 12 – signed by Governor; effective 7/1/2013 4/16/2013

- adds 2-DPMP

S.B. 48 – sent to dead bill file 4/1/2013

- adds 2-DPMP

Texas:

H.B. 1333 – placed on general state calendar 5/9/2013

- adds 2-DPMP, D2PM, MDAI, methedrone, pentedrone, amends generic language

S.B. 28 – filed 6/6/2013

- adds pentedrone

S.B. 264 – committee report sent to local & consent calendar 5/10/2013

- adds pentedrone

Utah:

H.B. 52 – signed by Governor; effective 5/14/2013 3/26/2013

- adds 4-MEC, a-PVP, butylone, ethylone, fluoroisocathinone, MOPPP, NRG-1, pentedrone, pentylone

United States Congress:

US HR315 – referred to subcommittee 2/28/2013

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, a-PPP, a-PVP, butylone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDAI, MDPPP, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1

US HR6312 – referred to committee 9/7/2012

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, a-PPP, a-PVP, butylone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDAI, MDPPP, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1

REGULATIONS –

Florida:

2012 FL REG TEXT 312013 (FL ADC 2ER12-1) – emergency rules; enacted 12/12/2012

- adds 4-MeMABP, pentedrone

Michigan:

2013 MI REG TEXT 331254 (R338.3113, 338.3114, 338.3114a) – proposed rules 7/15/2013

- adds generic language, a-PPP, ephedrone, ethcathinone, MDPV, mephedrone, methadrone, methylone, NRG-1

Nevada:

2013 NV REG TEXT 328935 – initial drafts 6/21/2013

- adds 4-MEC, a-PVP

New York:

2013 NY REG TEXT 305188 (10 NYCRR 9.1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) – enacted on emergency basis

11/5/2012; adopted 1/2/2013

- adds 3-FMC, 4-FMC, ethcathinone, methedrone, methylone

North Dakota:

2012 ND REG TEXT 312282 (ADC 61-13-01-01, 02, 03) – filed with Office of Legislative Council 4/1/2013

- adds generic language with the following as examples: 2-FMC, 3,4-DMMC, 3-FMC, 4-FMC, 4-MEC, a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, buphedrone, butylone, ethcathinone, ethylone, MDPPP, MDPV, mephedrone, metamfepramone, methedrone, methylone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, pentedrone

Texas:

2013 TX REG TEXT 318764 – annual republication; effective 21 days after publication of notice 2/22/2013

- adds MDPV, mephedrone

2013 TX REG TEXT 329566 – in addition 6/28/2013

- adds methylone

Vermont:

2012 VT REG TEXT 306843 (ADC 12-5-23: I – VIII) – enacted on emergency basis; in effect until 4/20/2013 12/21/2012

- adds 2-diphenylmethylpyrrolidine, 2-DPMP, 2-FMC, 3,4-DMMC, 3-FMC, 4-EMC, 4-FMC, 4-MBC, 4-MEC, a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, BZP, buphedrone, butylone, D2PM, dimethocaine, ethcathinone, ethylone, eutylone, HMMC, MaPPP, MBZP, MDAI, MDAT, MDPBP, MDPPP, metamfepramone, methedrone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, NRG-2, pentedrone, pentylone, generic language

2012 VT REG TEXT 311487 (ADC 12-5-23:I – VIII) – enacted; effective 3/2/2013 1/31/2013

- adds 2-diphenylmethylpyrrolidine, 2-DPMP, 2-FMC, 3,4-DMMC, 3-FMC, 4-EMC, 4-FMC, 4-MBC, 4-MEC, a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, BZP, buphedrone, butylone, D2PM, dimethocaine, ethcathinone, ethylone, eutylone, HMMC, MaPPP, MBZP, MDAI, MDAT, MDPBP, MDPPP, metamfepramone, methedrone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, NRG-2, pentedrone, pentylone, generic language

2013 VT REG TEXT 317654 (ADC 12-5-23:I – VIII) – emergency rules 2/13/2013

- adds 2-diphenylmethylpyrrolidine, 2-DPMP, 2-FMC, 3,4-DMMC, 3-FMC, 4-EMC, 4-FMC, 4-MBC, 4-MEC, a-PBP, a-PPP, a-PVP, BZP, buphedrone, butylone, D2PM, dimethocaine, ethcathinone, ethylone, eutylone, HMMC, MaPPP, MBZP, MDAI, MDAT, MDPBP, MDPPP, metamfepramone, methedrone, MOPPP, MPBP, NRG-1, NRG-2, pentedrone, pentylone, generic language

Wisconsin:

2013 WI REG TEXT 328043 – scope statements 6/14/2013

- adds methylone
