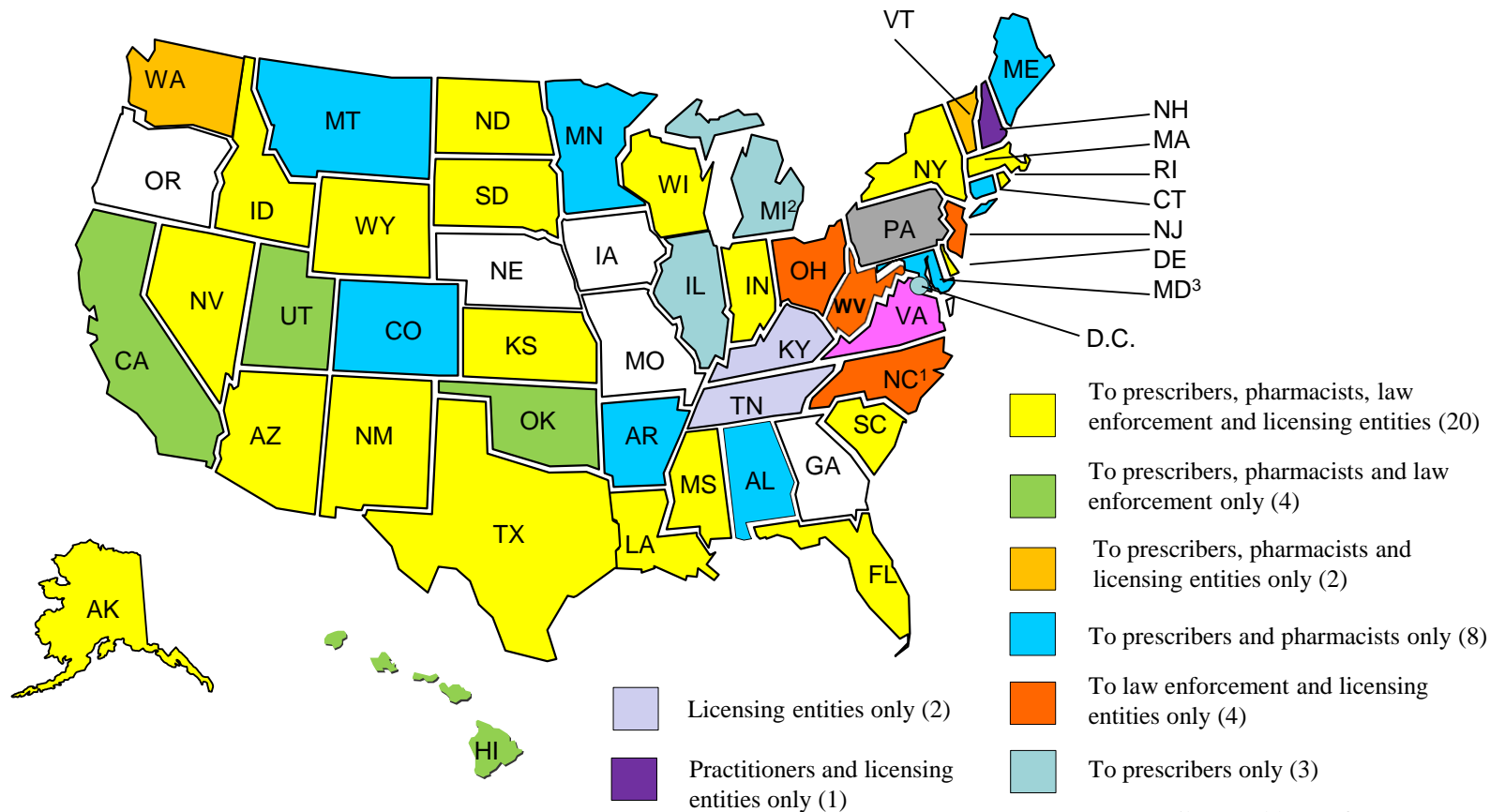

<sup>1</sup> North Carolina provides unsolicited reports to the Attorney General who has the discretion to forward the information to law enforcement. <sup>2</sup> Michigan send alerts to physicians when a patient surpasses the threshold but does not send the actual report. <sup>3</sup> The Maryland provision goes into effect on October 1, 2014.
