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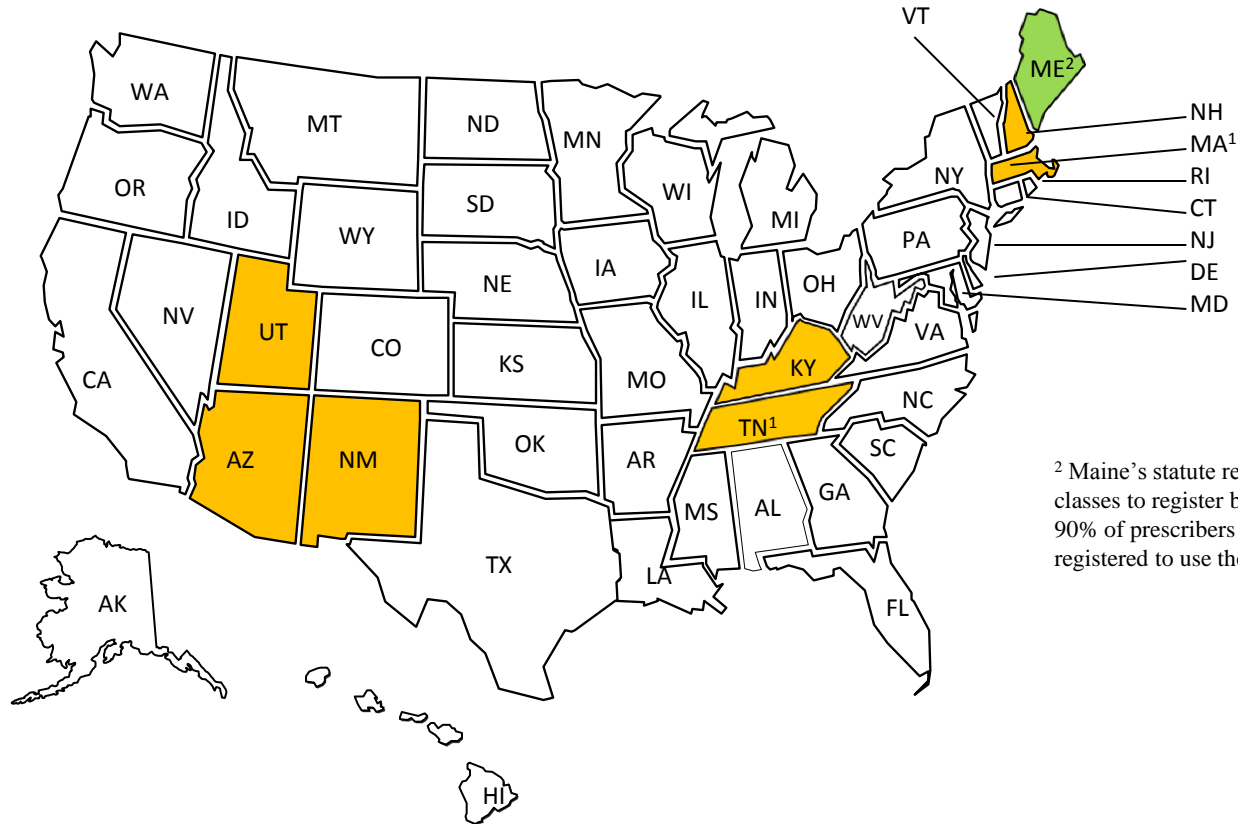

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States that Require All Licensed Prescribers and/or Dispensers to Register with PMP Database*



² Maine’s statute requires all prescribers in six classes to register by March 1, 2014 if less than 90% of prescribers in each class have not registered to use the PMP by January 1, 2014.

* Many states require that persons requesting access to the state PMP database first register as an authorized user. This map and the accompanying memorandum is concerned with only those states that require all practitioners licensed in the state to also register to use the PMP database.

¹ The Tennessee provision goes into effect on January 1, 2013. The Massachusetts provision also goes into effect on January 1, 2013, with the exception that those practitioners established as within the top 30% of prescribers of controlled substances in the preceding 12 months must register no later than January 1, 2013.
