




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### MANDATORY USE OF PMP




# MANDATORY REGISTRATION WITH PMP



20 states require that practitioners register with the PMP


7 states passed such a requirement since August 2013

### **USE OF DELEGATES**




5 states + DC passed such a statute or regulation since August 2013

# INCREASED TYPES OF AUTHORIZED RECIPIENTS



7 states increased the types of authorized recipients of PMP data

# UNSOLICITED REPORTING



45 states + DC provide unsolicited reports

4 states added or modified their unsolicited reporting statutes or regulations since August 2013
