Goals of PMIX Phase II

- ❑ Pilot capabilities for CA-NV exchange
- ❑ Reusable PMP-to-PMP exchange artifacts
 - Exchange data models (IEPDs)
 - ConOps
 - Acquisition support (e.g., gap analyses)
 - Architecture & design
- ❑ Foundation for extended reuse
 - PMP-to-other-State-agency
 - PMP-to-Federal (e.g., performance measures)

Perspective of State Participants

Selection of Pilot States

- Diverse states
- Neighboring states
- PMP Systems in place
- Presently sharing data informally
- Legislation allows for sharing of data
- Trust factor between PMP administrators
 - Validation of requestor
 - CA does not provide individual patient info to patient

California vs. Nevada

- ❑ Population: ~37 mil vs. ~2.4 mil
- ❑ Law enforcement / law enforcement computer system vs. regulatory
- ❑ Purchasing restrictions vs. no restrictions
